Adopt-a-Kindergarten: Professors visit the K5 classrooms to conduct hands-on activities, students visit the College for a tour in the spring, and students and parents participate in a K5 “graduation” ceremony at the College at the end of the year.

Free Admission to Sporting Events: Any student (and their immediate family members) may request an ID card, and gain free admission to any Thaddeus Stevens College sporting event (with adult supervision)

Free use of Thaddeus Stevens College Library: Any student in the School District of Lancaster may request an ID card and use the Thaddeus Stevens College library (with adult supervision)

Free Thaddeus Stevens College Experience Summer Camp: Any 5th and 6th grade student in the School District of Lancaster may attend the Stevens Experience summer camp at no cost.

Reduced Cost Tuition For Academic Courses During 11th And 12th Grade: Any 11th or 12th grade student in School District of Lancaster, who has maintained a 3.2+ GPA, may apply to enroll in a TSCT academic course during the Fall, Spring, and/or Summer terms.

Guaranteed Admission to the College Upon High School Graduation: Any graduate from the School District of Lancaster will be granted guaranteed admission to Thaddeus Stevens College of Technology if they have a high school unweighted GPA of 3.0 or higher, meet the Math and Evidence-Based Reading & Writing SAT college readiness benchmarks, and submit their application information by January 1 of their senior year.

Gain Access to the Stevens Grant Scholarship: Any graduate from School District of Lancaster is eligible for the Stevens Grant scholarship if they qualify for the Federal Pell Grant. Those that qualify for the Stevens Grant will have the costs of college tuition, meal plan, tools, and books covered partially or in its entirety as a student at Thaddeus Stevens College of Technology.
