



HACC Dual Enrollment Checklist

Registration Process

	Schedule a meeting with your counselor to discuss if dual enrollment is the right fit for you.		
	Complete the School District of Lancaster Dual Enrollment Request form and get your		
	counselor and campus administration's approval. You can get a request form from the		
	College and Career Center (JP 147, East A126) or the counseling office.		
	Once approved, visit the College and Career Center to discuss next steps.		
	Request a copy of your transcript be sent to HACC. You must request this from your counselor in person or via Xello.		
	The College and Career Center will email your application to HACC Admissions		
Counselor, Chala Thomas via email at cmthomas@hacc.edu .			
	After the application is processed by HACC you will receive a confirmation email to the		
	personal email provided on the application, followed by a second email from HACC		
	providing "myHACC" log-in information.		
	When you receive these emails, you must either schedule placement testing in reading,		
	writing, and math OR provide your SAT or ACT scores. Provide your SAT scores if you		
	scored 480 or above in Evidence-based Reading/Writing and 550 and above in math. If		
	you scored over these amounts, you do not need to take the placement test.		
	Take the placement test. You must have a photo ID to test. Testing is available at the		
	following times at the Main building at the Lancaster Campus (no appointment		
	necessary). Just stop by the Welcome Center to sign in:		
	Mondays between 9AM and 2PM		
Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays, between 9AM and 6PM Fridays between 9AM and 2PM			
	After placement testing, complete the course registration form to choose the desired class		
	for the semester. Students should speak with the HACC Admissions Counselor after		
	testing or coordinate a time to schedule classes. You can reach HACC Admissions		
	Counselor Chala Thomas at cmthomas@hacc.edu .		
<u>After</u>	Registration		
	Pick up your HACC ID at the Welcome Center		
	Pick-up your textbook voucher at the Welcome Center. Note you can only purchase items		
_	required for class. You will be billed for any additional expenses.		
	Pick up books at the HACC Bookstore: You will need HACC ID, Voucher, and current HACC schedule to get your books
